Eligible MATCH Sources

- Local funds, including local general funds and local bond funds.
- Private funds.
- Donated materials and services. (e.g., IN-KIND services, FORCE-ACCOUNT LABOR)
- Value of donated land (for ACQUISITION PROJECTS only).
- Federal funds.

Ineligible MATCH Source

State funds

Rules regarding MATCH

- MATCH can only be spent on ELIGIBLE COSTS.
- INDIRECT COSTS cannot be used as MATCH.
- The GRANT and the required MATCH amounts combined cannot pay for more than 25% of pre-construction costs (See ELIGIBLE COSTS chart on page 34) of the total HCF PROJECT.

Important Amounts to Know

GRANT Request Amount (Cannot exceed 50% of TOTAL PROJECT COST)		\$
(Califiot exceed 50% of TOTAL PROJECT COST)	+	
Required MATCH Amount (Must be a minimum of 100% of GRANT amount)		\$

How to calculate GRANT amount and MATCH amount based on the TOTAL PROJECT COST

Multiply the total cost of the $\frac{\text{PROJECT}}{\text{DECT}}$ by .50 to obtain the maximum $\frac{\text{GRANT}}{\text{GRANT}}$ amount and minimum required $\frac{\text{MATCH}}{\text{CH}}$ amount

Example:

Cost of total PROJECT is \$120,000

Multiply by .50 = \$60,000. This is the maximum <u>GRANT</u> amount and minimum <u>MATCH</u> amount.
