All final Applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for Law Enforcement Projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

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## **Law Enforcement: G25-03-30-L01**

### **Need Assessment**

- Item #3 – Applicant must elaborate beyond “Weekly” as it relates to the frequency of patrols. Applicant must provide more detailed information, such as scheduled hours, intervals, and seasonality of OHV patrols.
- Item #4 – Applicant needs to offer more precise details regarding the deployment of officers. Clearly define the planned number of officers dedicated to OHV patrol. Outline the number of days allocated for patrol per week, considering weekdays, holidays, weekends, etc. Identify the rank of personnel assigned to patrol duties.

### **Needs Enforcement Certification**

### **Project Cost Estimate**

- Staff All Line Items – Applicant must provide the duties and/or activities related to patrol for OHV Recreation to be performed on the Project. Applicant is reminded that primarily patrolling for anything other than OHV Recreational activities is ineligible.

- Staff #3 “Patrol Sergeants” – Applicant is allowed one first line supervisor which is Staff #2 “Corporal”. Applicant must clarify how this secondary supervisor is needed and further clarify the field work directly related to OHV patrol.
- Materials / Supplies #1 “Gloves, Helmets, Goggles” – Applicant must separate supplies into different line items.
- Equipment Purchase #1 “Jeep” – Applicant must further clarify the need, as the Agency already has two Jeeps in their fleet funded through the OHV Grant Program, as well as six trucks.
