Pending Litigation - Friends of Oceano Dunes v. San Luis Obispo Air Pollution Control District, et al., San Luis Obispo Superior Court Case Number 22CV-0231. Pursuant to California Government Code § 11126(e)(1) and (e)(2)(A), the Commission will hold a closed session at its meeting on July 28, 2023 in Sacramento, California to confer with and/or receive advice from its legal counsel regarding the pending litigation of Friends of Oceano Dunes v. San Luis Obispo Air Pollution Control District, et al. as discussion in open session concerning the litigation would prejudice the position of the Commission in the litigation.

XVI. ADJOURNMENT
