The information provided below is the OHMVR Division Factual Findings for this Applicant. The information provided reflects the OHMVR Division's review and determination of the Applicant's final Application.

Law Enforcement: G26-03-72-L01

Need Assessment

- Item #1 – Applicant is reminded enforcement of vehicle issues, including off-highway vehicles and e-motos, on paved roadways is an on-highway patrol issue. While the Division understands OHV use on roadways is an illegal activity, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 38000 et seq., the provisions of Division 16.5 apply exclusively to the operation of off-highway motor vehicles (CVC 38006) on lands other than highways (CVC 38001). Paved public roadways are legally classified as highways under the California Vehicle Code and therefore fall outside the jurisdictional scope of Division 16.5 and are not eligible for use of OHV Grant funds for patrol activities. Applicant is reminded that patrol activities should be primarily focused on vehicle recreation that occurs off highway on lands described in CVC 38001.

Needs Enforcement Certification

- #9 - Applicant is advised to set up a meeting with the Finance department to discuss In-Lieu funds and statutory requirements. California Vehicle code (CVC) §38240 states that (b) The funds collected under Section 38230 shall be used for the purposes set forth in Public Resources Code Sections 5090.50 which is the Grants program.

Project Cost Estimate

- Staff #3 "Deputy Training Time" - Per notes the total hours should be 700. Deduct 50 hrs. Deduct \$4,575 Grant and \$1,525 match.
- Equipment Purchases #1 - Contingent line item. Applicant may not purchase new ROV until a disposition form has been submitted to the Division and approved. If disposition is not approved, Applicant may not purchase the new ROV.
- Others #1 "Replacement OHV Trailer" - Contingent line item. Applicant may not purchase new trailer until a disposition form has been submitted to the Division and approved. If disposition is not approved, Applicant may not purchase the new trailer.

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Project Cost Estimate

- Staff #1 "Deputy Patrol..." - Job duties of "unscheduled maintenance on the jeep and Can Am" and "routine maintenance on both OHV vehicles" are indirect activities. Additionally, routine maintenance may only be "conducted by a licensed repair facility or agency personnel possessing comparable qualifications." It is unclear that the Deputies have this qualifications. Line item is reduced by 15%, 10% of line item shall be moved to Indirect. Deduct \$22,427 Grant. Move \$14,951 from the deduction to Indirect Grant. Deduct \$7,407 match. Move \$4,938 from the deduction to Indirect match.
- Staff #2 "SGT Patrol..." - Job duties of "unscheduled maintenance on the jeep and Can Am" and "routine maintenance on both OHV vehicles" are indirect activities. Additionally, routine maintenance may only be "conducted by a licensed repair facility or agency personnel possessing comparable qualifications." It is unclear that the Deputies have this qualifications. Line item is reduced by 15%, 10% of line item shall be moved to Indirect. Deduct \$1,294 Grant. Move \$836 from the deduction to Indirect Grant. Deduct \$431 match. Move \$287 from the deduction to Indirect match.
- Indirect - Due to deduction/movement Applicant has exceeded 15% maximum indirect. Deduct \$6,974 Indirect Grant and \$2325 Indirect match.
