STAFF REPORT: Oceano Dunes Ad Hoc Committee Goals 2024/2025

SUBJECT: Ad Hoc Committee, Oceano Dunes Goals 2024-2025

SHORT TERM GOALS:

1. Identify the path forward to reinstitute the seasonal plover enclosure ASAP;
2. Remove the derelict OHV/State Beach information kiosk and replace with the one that has been waiting in the maintenance yard ASAP;
3. Investigate options to move OHV vendors to another staging area on the beach to expand more coveted beach camping spaces ASAP;
4. Develop temporary analog (read: easy to do) system for tallying ingress and egress of day use visitors to allow additional day users while maintaining the required quota ASAP;
5. Explore camp host idea offered by public commenters during the May Commission meeting ASAP;
6. Get update on snowy plover and least tern overall use and nesting success under current ODSVRA conditions, including seasonal enclosures, historic 48-acre camping area, and other use areas.

LONGER TERM GOALS:

1. Land acquisition to create additional access to the SVRA and expand camping opportunities, such as the Phillips 66 acreage, or portions thereof (but maybe some ag land could be considered?);
2. Revisiting the Division's Public Works Plan, especially to put into action longer-term Coastal Commission permits for various uses and to activate plans that support OHV activity;
3. Discussion of action items currently in process and on our wish list to develop, maintain and improve relations between this Division, this Commission and other agencies, such as the Coastal Commission.
