Need Assessment

Needs Enforcement Certification

Project Cost Estimate

- Staff #4 "GS07 OHV Leads" – Applicant revised line item without Division or public comment. Line item is returned to preliminary request of 1600 hours. Deduct \$1,950 match.
- Staff #6 "District GS09 Rec Officer" – Duties related to this Project are indirect. Move line to indirect cost category.
- Materials/Supplies #2 "FPO Safety Equipment" – Tool kits, and straps are not considered PPE and are considered indirect. Additionally, Motoport Kevlar Mesh Upper (\$770), Motoprot Kevlar mesh pants (\$600) are excessive requests for the work being completed and may not be purchased. Line item is reduced \$405 Grant to Indirect Grant to remove tool kits and straps. Applicant must also deduct \$1,370 for excessive request. Line item total is now \$595.
- Materials/Supplies #3 & #4 – Line items are duplicate of the USFS El Dorado Ground Operations materials/supplies #2. Additionally, materials have been purchased in previous grant cycles and not installed. Line items are removed. Deduce \$14,000 Grant.
- Indirect #2 "VIS" – Line item is not eligible in a Law Enforcement grant. Line item was to be removed, not hours increased. Deduct \$11,760 match.
- Match - Due to deductions Applicant has not met required 25% match. Move \$7,087 Grant to match from any line item.
