This form is to be filled out by all prospective donors who are interested in donating an item to all parks within the Inland Empire State Park District. Please note that the submission of this form does not guarantee formal acceptance of the object(s) into the collections, and we do not accept materials on loan from the public. Once you submit the form, your proposed donation will be reviewed, and you should expect a response from our curator within three weeks. If chosen to be accepted into the collection, the curator will follow up with the next steps. You will be issued a deed of gift to document the transfer of ownership of the artwork, objects, images, or documents to the park. At that time, the curator will contact you to make arrangements for delivery of the accepted artifact(s). If we cannot accept your proposed donation, the curator will give you information about where else your donation could go.
