(2) PUBLIC COMMENT

- (b) Public comment period for all items not on the agenda: Those persons wishing to address the Commission on items not on the agenda during the public comment period should use the "Raise Hand" feature on Zoom or fill out the blue "Public Comment – Non Agenda Items" form and submit it to the Commission recording secretary. - (c) Written materials: Members of the public presenting written or graphic materials as part of their public comments to the Commission are requested to provide eight (8) copies to the Commission recording secretary at the beginning of the meeting.

Visual aids: Members of the public presenting visual aids (projected media) as part of their public comments to the Commission are requested to submit the material(s) to the Department of Parks and Recreation ten (10) days prior to the scheduled meeting.
