(2) PUBLIC COMMENT

(c) Written materials: Members of the public presenting written or graphic materials as part of their public comments to the Commission are requested to provide eight (8) copies to the Commission recording secretary at the beginning of the meeting.

Visual aids: Members of the public presenting visual aids (projected media) as part of their public comments to the Commission are requested to submit the material(s) to the Department of Parks and Recreation ten (10) days prior to the scheduled meeting. The Department reserves the right to decline to show photographs that violate personal privacy (photos without a release from the person/people shown in the photograph) or other valid reason in the opinion of the Department and its legal counsel.
