I would like to register a comment on CDBW Commission Agenda Item IV. B. Berkeley Marina Loan Program.

I have had a small 26ft sailboat sailboat for 5 years in Berkeley Marina, and have lived on it fulltime for the last 1.5 years.

My boat is one of the smallest legal liveaboards, and it has enabled me to stay in the Bay Area despite long periods of unemployment during and after the pandemic. Without it I would basically be homeless, or would have had to leave the area. I paid \$6700 for it, less than most people pay for their cars (I don't have a car myself, but ride a bicycle), so it's not a luxury item for me. I also pay rent for my slip, it's not a freebee from the city.

About 100 other people live here on their boats, some larger, some smaller. Of the hundreds of other slipholders, some are rich, some are poor, some use it for recreation, some to provide non-profit services to kids, but I'd like to think that it's a friendlier and more helpful community than you will find in most privately owned marinas.

Sadly the state of repair is not what it should be in such a great location, and we therefore badly need the docks to be repaired so we can keep this marina afloat, so I am hoping you will give your support to approving the loan.
