**Delta Meadows Property
Mooring Restrictions**

1. Mooring in Delta Meadows Property is intended for overnight recreational use.
2. Between May 1st and October 31st of each calendar year, except as otherwise permitted by this order, and in compliance with Sacramento County Ordinance 6.42.110, no transitory vessel shall be moored, anchored, grounded, placed, or otherwise located in Delta Meadows Property for a period exceeding fourteen (14) days without a permit issued by the Sheriff of Sacramento County (Sheriff) and California State Parks. This 14-day period is consecutive and will commence upon written notice by the Sheriff or California State Parks. Prior to the issuance of any permit under this order, owners or operators of vessels shall allow the Sheriff and/or California State Parks designee to board and inspect the onboard sewage reception system and place a dye tablet within the sewage reception system to determine compliance with the Sacramento County ordinance and this order.
3. Any transitory vessel moored within the waters of Delta Meadows Property for greater than fourteen (14) days shall be equipped with the following:
 - A. An operable Coast Guard certified marine sanitation device in accordance with Sacramento County Code Section 6.42.110(B)(1)(a)(b) and (c); or
 - B. A self-contained portable toilet; or
 - C. Or other onboard portable sewage reception system that prevents the overboard discharge of treated or untreated excrement, sewage, or other waste matter or contaminant of any kind.
4. In accordance with Sacramento County ordinance 6.42.120, mooring and anchoring will be allowed in the Delta Meadows Property for a period of up to one hundred eighty (180) days from May 1st to October 31st of each calendar year.
 - A. Vessels utilizing this anchorage for this time period are required to comply with the regulations of this order and are subject to sanitation system inspections by the Sheriff or California State Parks every thirty (30) days.
 - B. Vessels subject to this section and utilizing a Type III MSD or portable MSD will be required to show proof of pump out from a commercial waste removal service or from a marina or municipal service during the period they are in the Delta Meadows Property.
 - i. Proof of a pump out will be required every thirty (30) days for those vessels equipped with a holding tank of 100 gallons or less, from the date of initial inspection by the Sheriff and/or California State Parks.

ii. Proof of a pump out will be required every forty-five (45) days for those vessels equipped with a holding tank of 101 to 150 gallons, from the date of initial inspection by the Sheriff and/or California State Parks.

iii. Proof of a pump out will be required every ninety (90) days for those vessels equipped with a holding tank of 150 gallons or more, from the date of initial inspection by the Sheriff and/or California State Parks.

5. Vessels mooring or anchoring within the Delta Meadows Property must also adhere to all Sacramento County ordinances under Chapter 6.42.
6. Vessels may not anchor or moor within the Delta Meadows Property between November 1st and April 30th of each calendar year.
7. Vessels mooring in this area must retain any permits and provide it to authorities upon request. Vessels will be issued a permit number from California State Parks and must post the permit number issued visibly in two locations, one as seen from the bow and one from the stern.
8. Vessels anchored or moored to the land on California State Parks Property may not utilize State Park lands for recreational use, erect structures, harm plants and wildlife, have ground fires, or alter the land in any way. Vessels may moor to trees using rope but must do so without damaging the tree. Vessels may drive a mooring stake into the ground but must remove said stake when unmoored.
9. Any vessel not intended for overnight recreational use shall not be left in the Delta Meadows Property abandoned. All abandoned vessels will be removed from the property after 72 hours' notice and stored by California State Parks until claimed or disposed of after thirty (30) days of storage.

11. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private, contractual, and residential or property rights.
12. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore California 94550.

Nothing herein shall be construed to be in derogation of other provisions of law.
