Temporary Closure- Folsom Lake & Lake Clementine

Effective Monday April 14, 2025, the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation will require all trailered or motorized vessels launching at Folsom Lake and Lake Clementine to participate in a 30-day vessel quarantine program to help prevent the spread of golden mussel.

During this time, Folsom Lake at Folsom Lake SRA and Lake Clementine at Auburn SRA will be temporarily closed to all trailered or motorized vessels launching from April 14, 2025, through May 13, 2025.

This order will expire on May 13, 2025 at 10:00pm.

Exceptions:

- 1. Employees, officers, contractors, lessees, and pennittees of the California Department of Parks and Recreation and U.S. Bureau of Reclamation entering the area on official business.
- 2. Vessels moored in the water at Browns Marina prior to the lake closure.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Gold Fields District Superintendent at 7755 Folsom-Auburn Road, Folsom, CA 95630.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
