2023 Fall Hunting Season

Turkey: (Rifle or Archery) November 11th through December 10th

- Daily Bag Limit: 1 (*Either Sex*)
- Possession Limit: 2 per Season

Band-Tailed Pigeon: (Shotgun) December 16th – 24th Southern Zone

- Daily Bag Limit: 2
- Possession Limit: Triple Daily Bag Limit

<u>Dove:</u> (Shotgun) September 1st – 15th & November 11th – December 25th

- Daily Bag Limit: Varies Based on Species; Mourning & White Tailed – 15, 10 of which may be White Tailed
- Possession Limit: Triple Daily Bag Limit

Quail: (Shotgun) October 21th – January 28th Zone Q1 & Q3

- Daily Bag Limit: 10
- Possession Limit: Triple Daily Bag Limit

Deer Archery: August 19th – September 10th AO

Bag Limit: 1 Buck with Forked Horn or better per tag

<u>Deer General:</u> (Shotgun or Rifle) September 23rd – October 29th D-4 & D-5

• Bag Limit: 1 Buck with Forked Horn or better per tag

As of July 1, 2019 non-lead ammo is <u>required</u> in the State of California

Upland Game Birds: Shooting time starts 30 minutes prior to Sunrise and ends at Sunset

Deer: Shooting time starts 30 minutes prior to Sunrise and ends 30 minutes after Sunset

You must possess, while hunting, a valid CA Hunting License and appropriate tag or stamps depending on species hunted.

All Fish & Wildlife rules and regulations are enforced in the ASRA.

You are responsible to know all the rules and regulations for hunting and using the ASRA. Not all areas are open for hunting. Maps are available at the office or on our website.
