DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S POSTED ORDER No. 008-25-680-203

**Mount Diablo State Park
Fire Danger-Closure**

1. WHEREAS, there can exist in Mount Diablo State Park a varying level of fire danger that poses a threat to the safety of the visiting public, and
2. WHEREAS, this varying degree of fire danger also poses a severe threat to the preservation of all park resources;
3. THEREFORE, from time to time, when conditions so warrant, parklands, facilities, or portions thereof shall be declared a Prohibited Area under the following procedure:
 - A. The Park Superintendent has the authority to prohibit public use, entry, or occupancy of parklands, facilities, or portions thereof when moderate, high, very high or extreme fire conditions warrant.
 - B. All prohibitions will be based on the Mount Diablo State Park fire danger rating matrix, as found attached and located in the Mount Diablo State Park Fire Management Plan.
 - C. In addition to the restrictions in # 2 above, during a National Weather Service Posted Red Flag Warning for the East Bay Hills of the San Francisco Bay Area, all fires including charcoal briquettes will be prohibited within Mount Diablo State Park. Self-contained propane or gas-powered cook stoves will be permitted.
4. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Telsa Road, Livermore California 94550.
5. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.
6. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.

² Park Closure applies to all vehicles, hikers, bicyclists (mountain and road), and horseback riders.

Fires shall at all times be maintained in safe condition that does not threaten any person, natural or structural feature.
 Never leave a fire unattended.
 Extinguish all fires prior to departure.
 Ground fires are not permitted.
 Firewood gathering is prohibited.
 The possession or discharge of fireworks is prohibited.
 Report all wildfires immediately.
 Ask a Park Ranger for further information.
