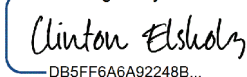

**Mount Diablo State Park
Temporary Closure For Mount Diablo Challenge**

1. The paved roads within Mount Diablo State Park (North Gate, South Gate and Summit Roads) are hereby closed to the public from Midnight on the first Saturday of October to 1:00pm on the first Sunday of October, every year, for the Annual Mount Diablo Challenge Special Event.
2. In addition- all participants in the Annual Mount Diablo Challenge are required to wear a bicycle helmet that meets the Consumer Products Safety Commission (CPSC) standard while riding his or her bicycle during the course of the event.
3. These closures are not applicable to the following persons:
 - A. State Park personnel
 - B. Companies delivering materials and contractors working on approved projects within the unit.
 - C. Cal-Fire emergency response personnel and equipment.
 - D. Other vehicles, equipment, and personnel approved by California State Parks representatives.
4. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore, California 94550.
5. Nothing herein shall affect any existing concession contract, private contract, or property rights.
6. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
