

Closure Due to Wildland Fire

- Effective immediately, to provide for public safety, security, safeguarding, and preservation of resources, the following trails in the area known as the Torrey Pines State Natural Reserve Extension in San Diego Coast District are hereby declared a prohibited area and temporarily closed to all public use:
 - Margaret Fleming Nature Trail
- Exception to this order is for State Park staff, its contractors and personnel acting on behalf of State Parks, or for special projects with prior approval.
- Exceptions to this order may be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, 4477 Pacific Highway, San Diego, CA 92110.
- Nothing in this order shall affect private contract or property rights.
- Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
