Minimum Qualifications

Graduation from college with major work in interpretation, social sciences, natural sciences, communications, or closely related fields **AND** five years experience in planning and implementing historical or natural resource interpretive programs with two years in a supervisory or program administrative capacity.

State Park Interpreter II

Monthly Salary: \$4,905—\$6,142

Minimum Qualifications

Graduation from college with major work in interpretation, social sciences, natural sciences, communications, or closely related fields **AND** three years experience in planning and implementing historical or natural resource interpretive programs with extensive contact with groups.

State Park Interpreter I

Monthly Salary: \$4,276—\$5,354

Minimum Qualifications

Graduation from college with major work in interpretation, social sciences, natural sciences, communications, or closely related fields **AND** one year experience in research and development of historical or natural resource interpretive programs.

Park Interpretive Specialist (Seasonal)

Earn: \$13—\$23 per hour

Minimum Qualifications

College graduate **OR** two years experience with preparing/presenting information or exhibits on natural, social, or cultural history through various platforms.
