DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Perform a well yield test on a new test well in Salt Point SP to determine the amount of water the well can sustainably produce over a 72-hour span, at 40 gallons per minute (GPM). The test will be used to ensure the water supply meets park needs, check for potential for the well to run dry, and evaluate the pump and pressure tank functionality.
