PROJECT TITLE: Marsh Creek State Park Waterline Replacement

LOCATION: Marsh Creek State Park

COUNTY: Contra Costa

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The purpose of this project is to replace up to 1,240 feet of broken water pipeline at Marsh Creek State Park to provide water to the park's resident. Work will:

- Use heavy equipment to excavate and remove 1,200 feet of the old 2-inch water supply pipe;
- Within the same footprint, install up to 1,200 feet of new 2-inch steel pipe;
- Use up to 75 couplers to join the pipe lengths;
- Excavate and remove up to 40 feet of an old ¾-inch pipe spur at the water trough;
- Within the same footprint, use up to 6 couplers to install a new 2-inch steel pipe spur;
- Backfill trenches with excavated materials; and
- Dispose of any removed defunct pipe.
